FORMULARY CHANGES

Effective with the date of service of **May 13, 2002**, the following agents are **DELETED** from the Chronic Renal Disease Program's (CRDP) formulary:

- *Tolbutamide (Orinase®)
- *Clemastine (Tavist®)
- *Trimethoprim (Trimpex®)

- Secobarbital (Seconal®)
- Guanabenz (Wytensin®)
- Guanfacine (Tenex®)
- Guanethidine (Ismelin®)

*CRDP Cardholders *currently receiving Tolbutamide (Orinase®) Clemastine (Tavist®) or Trimethoprim (Trimpex®)* through CRDP will receive a medical exception to permit the continuation of therapy.

Effective immediately the following agent is **ADDED** to the Chronic Renal Disease Program's (CRDP) formulary:

4 Pantoprazole Sodium (Protonix®)
