Insulin and HIV Medications

Effective Tuesday, June 1, 2021 PACE will require an appropriate ICD-10 code upon all claim submissions for reimbursement of Insulin and HIV medications.

- **For ALL NEW prescriptions with a Date Written after Monday, May 31, 2021, the ICD10 code shall be noted on the prescription, either by the prescriber or obtained by the pharmacy staff for auditing purposes.**
- **Reimbursement for HIV and Insulin medications will now require completion of the clinical segment including **Diagnosis Code (field 424-DO), Diagnosis Code Count (field 491-VE), and Diagnosis Code Qualifier (field 492-WE)****
- **Reimbursement of Insulin will require an ICD-10 of E10 or E11 (field 424-DO)**
- **Reimbursement for HIV medications will now require an ICD-10 code of B20, R75 or Z21 (field 424-DO)**

If either medication is submitted without a proper code, it will be returned with NCPDP 80- “DX code Submitted Does Not Meet Drug Coverage Criteria”.

- **No overrides are available.**
- **Reimbursement will not be provided without a proper code.**
