SPBP CARDHOLDERS with NON-PART D PRESCRIPTION PLANS

Some SPBP cardholders may have a primary prescription plan which is not Part D coverage. These cardholders may be required by their primary insurance carrier to obtain 90 day supplies of medication. Currently however, unless the primary is a Part D plan, claims submitted for a 90 day supply of SPBP covered medication deny when the quantity exceeds 100 tablets or capsules.

Effective February 23, 2010, SPBP will accept claims submitted with an OCC (Other Coverage Code) of 2 and a primary Amount Paid appearing in field 431-DV for 90 day supplies of SPBP formulary drugs. This change permits SPBP to be billed the primary plan's patient responsibility or copay in field 433-DX.
